

**SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT
PETER KIEWIT SONS', INC. HEALTH AND WELFARE PLAN**

This is a summary of the annual report of the Peter Kiewit Sons', Inc. Health and Welfare Plan (EIN: 91-1842817) for the Plan Year which began January 1, 2020, and ended December 31, 2020. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Peter Kiewit Sons', Inc. has committed itself to pay certain medical, prescription drug, dental, vision, and short term disability claims incurred under the terms of the Plan.

Insurance Information

The Plan has contracts with insurance providers to pay certain claims incurred under the terms of the Plan. The following premiums were paid to each provider for the policy periods that ended with or within the December 31, 2020 Plan Year:
